## 1 Introduction

The purpose of the Pormpuraaw Service Directory is for community to have access to essential services and provide an understanding of what services are available to Pormpuraaw community.

## 2 Service Types

Three categories of services are included in this directory.

- 1. Universal services:**  
Services which are universally available to everyone. There is no requirement for people using these services to have a special issue or problem and participation is by choice.
- 2. Secondary services:**  
Are aimed at individuals and families who are at risk, in crisis or vulnerable in one or more ways; and have more complex needs than those provided by universal services. These services are targeted and aim to prevent the likelihood of specific issues worsening or provide supports for recovery from a crisis
- 3. Tertiary services:**  
Are made up of both statutory protection and care services. They are targeted at individuals and families where abuse and neglect has already occurred or is at imminent risk of occurring. Tertiary services seek to address the consequences of abuse and neglect, and develop strategies or take action to prevent further abuse or neglect from occurring.

The category of service is colour coded in the services provided box in each table **Green** – Universal **Yellow** – Secondary, **Red** - Tertiary
